

AppleTalk: Using Multiple Versions on Same Network

How many versions of AppleTalk can we run on a 20-Macintosh network? We currently have version 56 on most of the computers.

This article has been archived and is no longer updated by Apple. There should be no incompatibilities between various versions of AppleTalk. It's important to know that AppleTalk phase 2 was introduced with AppleTalk version 53.

AppleTalk version 56 introduced many bug fixes and should be the minimum version in use on any network with highly utilized servers or routers. Most of the bug fixes included in version 56 were related to crashes and other problems with nodes operating in a high stress environment.
